(ii) The buyer will be receiving the real property "as is," with all defects, including latent defects, that may exist, except as otherwise provided in the contract of sale of the property.

At the time the disclosure or disclaimer statement is delivered to you ("the buyer"), you are required to date and sign a written acknowledgement of receipt on the disclosure or disclaimer statement which shall be included in or attached to the contract of sale.

Section 10-702 further provides that a buyer who receives the disclosure or disclaimer statement on or before entering into a contract of sale does not have the right to rescind the contract based upon the information contained in the disclosure or disclaimer statement.

You are hereby notified that, in certain circumstances, you have the right to rescind your contract with the seller if the seller fails to deliver to you the written property condition disclosure or disclaimer statement. Section 10-702 provides that a buyer who does not receive the disclosure or disclaimer statement on or before entering into the contract has the unconditional right, upon written notice to the seller or seller's agent:

- (i) To rescind the contract at any time before the receipt of the disclosure or disclaimer statement or within 5 days following receipt of the disclosure or disclaimer statement; and
- (ii) To the immediate return of any deposits made on account of the contract.

Your right to rescind the contract under Section 10-702 terminates if not exercised before making a written application to a lender for a mortgage loan, if the lender discloses in writing at or before the time application is made that the right to rescind terminates on submission of the application or within 5 days following receipt of a written disclosure from a lender who has received your application for a mortgage loan, if the lender's disclosure states that your right to rescind terminates at the end of that 5 day period.

Your rights as a buyer under Section 10-702 may not be waived in the contract and any attempted waiver is void. Your rights as the buyer to terminate the contract under Section 10-702 are waived conclusively if not exercised before

- (i) Closing or occupancy by you, whichever occurs first, in the event of a sale; or
- (ii) Occupancy, in the event of a lease with option to purchase.

The information contained in the property condition disclosure statement is the representation of the seller and not the representation of the real estate broker or sales person, if any. A disclosure by the seller is not a substitute for an inspection by an independent professional home inspection company. You should consider obtaining such an inspection. The information contained in a disclosure statement by the seller is not a warranty by the seller as to the condition of the property of which condition the seller has no actual knowledge or other condition, including latent defects, of which the seller has no actual knowledge. #### NOTICE TO SELLER AND PURCHASER

Section 10-702 of the Real Property Article, Annotated Code of Maryland, requires the seller of certain residential real property to furnish to the purchaser either (a) a RESIDENTIAL PROPERTY DISCLAIMER STATEMENT stating that the seller is selling the property "as is" and makes no representations or warranties as to the condition of the property or any improvements on the real property, except as otherwise provided in the contract of sale, or in a listing of latent defects; or (b) a RESIDENTIAL PROPERTY DISCLOSURE STATEMENT disclosing defects or other information about the condition of the real property actually known by the seller. - 3. A sale by a lender, or an affiliate or subsidiary of a lender, that acquired the real property by foreclosure or deed in lieu of foreclosure;
- 4. A sheriff's sale, tax sale, or sale by foreclosure, partition, or by court appointed trustee;
- 5. A transfer by a fiduciary in the course of the administration of a decedent's estate, guardianship, conservatorship, or trust;
- 6. A transfer of single family Residential Real Property to be converted by the buyer into use other than residential use or to be demolished; or
- 7. A sale of unimproved real property.

Section 10-702 also requires the seller to disclose information about latent defects in the property that the seller has actual knowledge of. The seller must provide this information even if selling the property "as is." "Latent defects" are defined as: Material defects in real property or an improvement to real property that:

- (1) A purchaser would not reasonably be expected to ascertain or observe by a careful visual inspection of the real property; and
- (2) Would pose a direct threat to the health or safety of:
  - (i) the purchaser; or
  - (ii) an occupant of the real property, including a tenant or invitee of the purchaser.

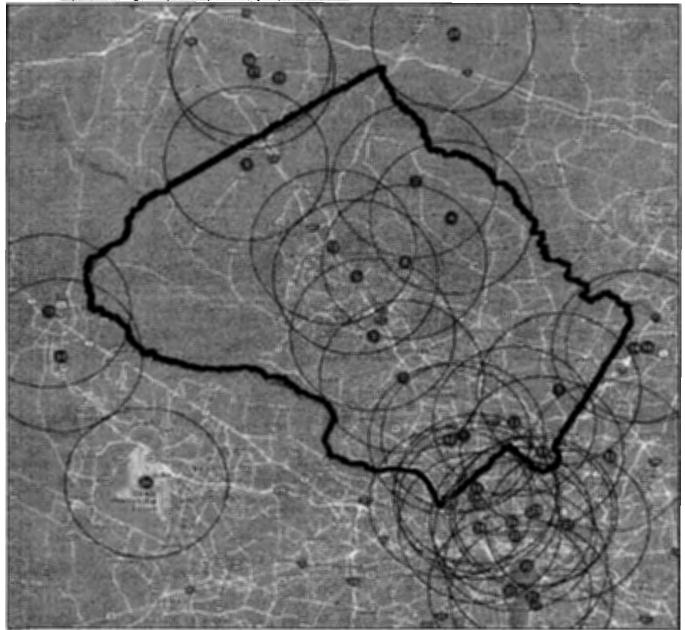

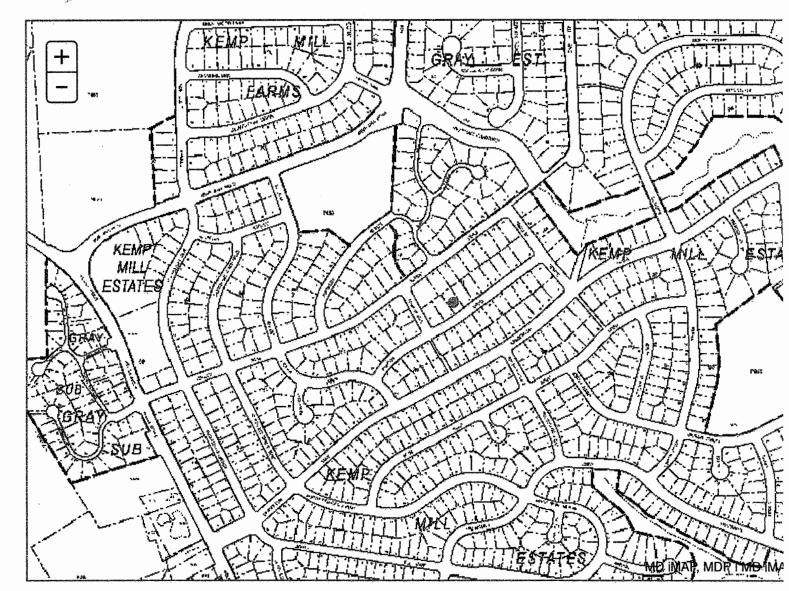

## **Duties of a Dual Agent and Intra-Company Agent**

Like other agents, unless the client gives consent to disclose the information, dual agents and intra-company agents must keep confidential information about a client's bargaining position or motivations. For example, without written consent of the client, a dual agent or intra-company agent may not disclose to the other party, or the other party's agent:

- 1) Anything the client asks to be kept confidential; \*
- 2) That the seller would accept a lower price or other terms;
- 3) That the buyer would accept a higher price or other terms;
- 4) The reasons why a party wants to sell or buy, or that a party needs to sell or buy quickly; or
- 5) Anything that relates to the negotiating strategy of a party.
- \* Dual agents and intra-company agents must disclose material facts about a property to all parties.

## **How Dual Agents Are Paid**

## NOTIFICATION OF DUAL AGENCY WITHIN A TEAM

A team that provides real estate brokerage services must consist of two or more associate brokers or salespersons, or a combination of the two, who:

- 1. work together on a regular basis;
- 2. represent themselves to the public as being part of one entity; and
- 3. designate themselves by a collective name such as "team" or "group."

The team operates within a brokerage, and team members are supervised by a team leader as well as by the broker, and, if they work in a brokerage branch office, by the branch office manager.

The law permits one member of a team to represent the buyer and one member to represent the seller in the same transaction only if certain conditions are met. If both parties agree, the **broker** of the real estate brokerage with which the salespersons or associate brokers are affiliated, or **broker's designee** (the "dual agent") shall designate one team member as the intra-company agent for the buyer and another team member as the intra-company agent for the seller. No one else may make that designation.

The law also requires that the buyer and seller each be notified in writing that the two agents are members of the same team, and that the team could have a financial interest in the outcome of the transaction in addition to any financial benefit obtained by selling one of the broker's own listings. THIS FORM CONSTITUTES YOUR NOTICE OF THOSE FACTS.

Dual agency may occur only if both parties consent to it, and sign the Consent for Dual Agency form prescribed by the Real Estate Commission. If you have concerns or questions about being represented by a team member when another team member represents the other party, you should address these to the broker or branch office manager before signing the Consent form.

This form must be presented to the buyer and seller at the time that the real estate licensee presents the disclosure of agency relationships. For the seller, that should occur no later than when the seller signs the listing agreement. For the buyer, that should occur no later than the initial scheduled showing of property.
